COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP AWARD PROGRAM

SPONSORED BY

CHICAGO MIDWEST MEAT ASSOCIATION

FOR CHILDREN OF EMPLOYEES OF MEMBERS OF THE ASSOCIATION

The Chicago-Midwest Meat Association will provide fifteen (15) scholarships, renewable annually for four (4) years. The award is for Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000) initially, renewable at the same rate for four (4) years of undergraduate study in a college or university. The funds will be used to meet the cost of tuition and fees.

It is the goal of the Association to award up to fifteen (15) scholarships annually to children of employees. If there are no applicants of sufficient merit in a given year then none will be awarded. It should also be noted that if, in the judgment of the Association Scholarship Committee, funds are not sufficient to support renewals in years subsequent to the initial award, renewals may be cancelled.

ELIGIBILITY

The Association Scholarship Committee will determine the eligibility of applicants.

In order to be considered for a CMMA scholarship award, applicants must be the children of qualified employees of the Chicago Midwest Meat Association, for at least one (1) year prior to making application.

Payments in subsequent years are contingent upon the student's academic good standing and the parent's continued employment with a member of the Association.

AWARD CRITERIA

Scholarships are awarded on the basis of the applicant's past accomplishments and the promise of future academic success. Official transcripts are required for school and/or college records.

High School Graduates: High school class rank, college aptitude test scores (ACT or SAT), school honors/awards, and extracurricular accomplishments.

Community college transfers: College GPA, and credit hours completed per semester. Any honors/awards, extracurricular accomplishments, and any other information (e.g., recent high school records and college aptitude test score) relevant to a judgment as to future college performance. Community college students applying for a scholarship to a four-year institution prior to completion of their community college programs should indicate the reasons supporting early transfer to a four-year institution.

Delayed college enrollees: Applicants, who have decided upon college enrollment after five or more years since high school graduation, or their most recent college enrollment, must submit information useful to the Scholarship Committee in making a judgment regarding potential college success. Such information may include any formal or informal educational experiences in which the applicant has engaged, and employment, volunteer or community activities that have a bearing on potential college success. It is strongly advised that delayed college scholarship applicants submit recommendations from those qualified to do so, and a written statement from the applicant indicating the reasons for wishing to pursue college enrollment at this time, and any other information from the applicant that would be relevant to the scholarship award committee.

Students must fully complete the application form items which pertain to them, give it to their high school official for completion of additional items (enclosure of required documents such as high school transcripts, test scores, record of extra-curricular accomplishments) and mail to the above address.

Applications must be received in the Association office no later than July 9th of the year in which college attendance is to begin. Only completed applications will be considered. A completed application consists of the completed and signed application form and the supporting documents noted above, all must be received by July 9th.

La Chicago-Midwest Meat Association proporcionará quince (15) becas renovables anualmente por cuatro (4) años. El premio es por tres mil dólares (\$ 3,000) inicialmente, renovable a la misma tasa por cuatro (4) años de estudios de pregrado en un colegio o universidad. Los fondos se usarán para cubrir el costo de la matrícula y las tarifas.

El objetivo de la Asociación es otorgar hasta quince (15) becas por año a hijos de empleados. Si no hay solicitantes de mérito suficiente en un año determinado, no se otorgará ninguno. También se debe tener en cuenta que si, a juicio del Comité de Becas de la Asociación, los fondos no son suficientes para respaldar las renovaciones en años posteriores a la adjudicación inicial, las renovaciones pueden cancelarse.

ELEGIBILIDAD

El Comité de Beca de Asociación determinará la elegibilidad de candidatos.

A fin de ser considerado para un premio de beca CMMA, los candidatos deben ser los niños de empleados calificados del Chicago Asociación de Carne de Midwest, durante al menos un año antes de la fabricación de la aplicación.

Los pagos en años subsecuentes son el contingente sobre posición buena académica del estudiante y empleo continuado del padre con un miembro de la Asociación.

CRITERIOS DE PREMIO

Las becas son concedidas sobre la base de los logros pasados del candidato y la promesa del futuro éxito académico. Las transcripciones oficiales son requeridas para archivos de colegio y/o escuela.

Diplomados: la fila de clase de escuela secundaria, tanteos de prueba de aptitud de colegio (ACTÚAN O SENTADO), los honores/premios escolares, y los logros extraescolares.

Transferencias de centro universitario: Colegio GPA, y horas de crédito completadas por semestre. Honores/premios, logros extraescolares, y cualquier otra información (p.ej, la escuela secundaria reciente registra y resultado de prueba de aptitud de colegio) relevante a un juicio en cuanto a la futura interpretación de colegio. los estudiantes de centro universitario que solicitan una beca a una institución de cuatro años antes de la finalización de sus programas de centro universitario deberían indicar que los motivos que apoyan temprano se trasladan a una institución de cuatro años.

Inscritos de colegio retrasados: los Candidatos, que se han decidido sobre la inscripción de colegio después de cinco o más años desde la graduación de escuela secundaria, o su inscripción de colegio más reciente, deben presentar la información útil al Comité de Beca en la fabricación de un juicio en cuanto al éxito de colegio potencial. Tal información puede incluir cualquier experiencia educativa formal o informal en la cual el candidato ha engranado, y empleo, voluntario o actividades de comunidad que tienen un tener que ver éxito de colegio potencial. Es fuertemente aconsejado lo que tardó los candidatos de beca de colegio presentan recomendaciones de aquellos calificados para hacer así, y una declaración escrita del candidato que indica los motivos de desear perseguir la inscripción de colegio en este tiempo, y cualquier otra información del candidato que sería relevante al comité de premio de beca.
